#### **Conservatives slash GP funding**

Whilst NHS waiting lists near record numbers and demand for services grow, the Conservatives have slashed GP funding in Dorset by nearly £7.5 million in real terms since 2019.

Funding per patient across Dorset has fallen by -7.4% since 2019.

Christchurch Liberal Democrats are calling for patients to be given a legal right to see their GP within 24-hours if in urgent need.

This would be achieved by increasing the number of

fully qualified GPs by 8,000 with an initiative to boost recruitment and retain more experienced doctors.

Lib Dem candidate for Christchurch Mike Cox said:

> "Seeing your GP should be at the heart of our NHS. Families and pensioners in our area are currently struggling to see their GP despite being in need of medical advice, leaving people waiting in pain or simply anxious about not getting the care they need."
